Welcome and Introductions	Following induction of all Tranche 3 development groups, members of the LCCS development group were welcomed by the chair. The Executive made a presentation on timelines, context and the report on the Early Enactment Review (EER).
Discussion of recommendations from the EER report	The current specification and the recommendations from the EER report were distributed and discussed in four breakout groups. The recommendations in the report were broadly welcomed. Deliberations covered the purpose of ALT1, balancing breadth with depth, ALT3 modifications, and specific areas such as the Turing Machine, Algorithmic Complexity, AI, Cloud Computing, agile v waterfall processes and binary arithmetic.
Migration to the new template	An overview of the new template for re-developed LC subjects was presented. The current specification, with modifications to the strands of learning informed by the first meeting, will be migrated to the new template.
Reflection and next steps	Next Meeting: Wednesday, October 23 rd , 2024 The chair reflected on the work done and thanked the members for their attendance and active engagement. The Executive will distribute the first draft of the re-developed specification in advance of the next meeting.
