Induction	<p>An induction session was held which provided:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • an overview of senior cycle reform, • the role of the NCCA and • the role of the development group in terms of development of an SEN programme at senior cycle <p>The group introduced themselves and gave a brief synopsis of their areas of expertise</p>
Plan of Work	<p>Discussions were had in relation to the L1/L2 LP and how this would inform the new modules at senior cycle. A focus on the modules being student centred was highlighted and that all modules would be informed by research</p>
Early Enactment Review	<p>The Education Officer gave a brief outline on the Review of the L1/L2 LP and shared some emerging themes</p>
Issues going Forward	<p>The group shared their experiences of working with students with SEN in mainstream and in special schools. They highlighted issues around flexible approaches to learning and teaching and assessment and the role of the community in supporting such a programme</p>
Next Steps	<p>Next Meeting 11-1-23</p> <p>The Chair brought the meeting to a close and reiterated the valuable work the group were now engaged in. He highlighted that this piece of work would inform the whole SC redevelopment process. The Chair asked the group to bring specific issues from the own context to the next meeting for discussion.</p>
